

Pedestrian Underpass

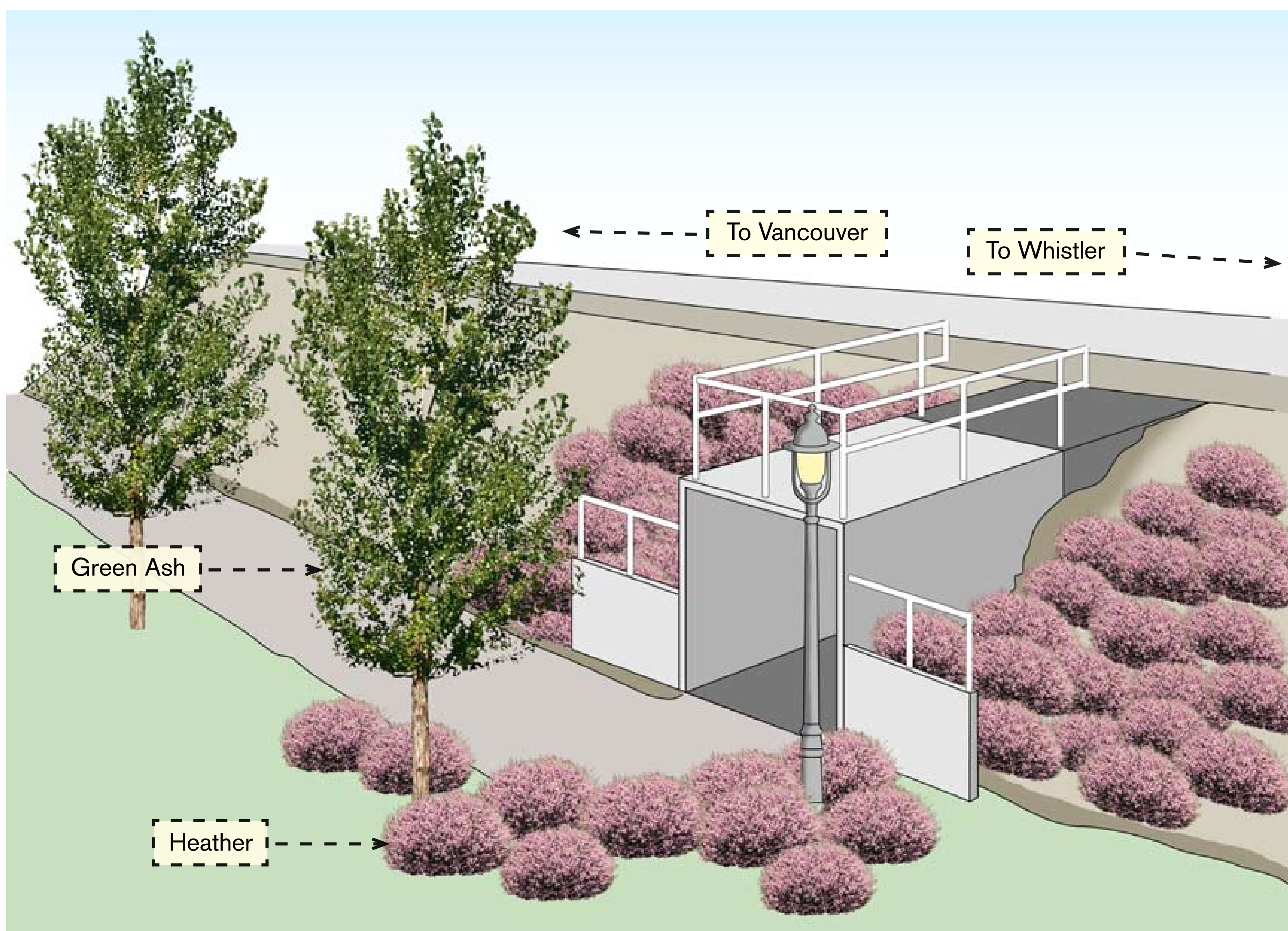
In response to community input, the pedestrian underpass design has been revised to a 2.4m high by 2.4m wide concrete box culvert. This design provides more width than the culvert design and better facilitates two-way movement within the underpass. In consideration of the 42m length of the underpass, ceiling mounted lights will be provided along its length to illuminate passage along the underpass. At each end of the structure, a lamp standard will be placed outside of the entrance to more clearly identify the entry location.

The landscaping around the pedestrian underpass entrances has been designed to enhance the appearance around the underpass structure without reducing visibility of the entrance itself. To achieve this objective, and to provide consistency with the south intersection landscaping that already exists, heather was selected as the planting for this area.

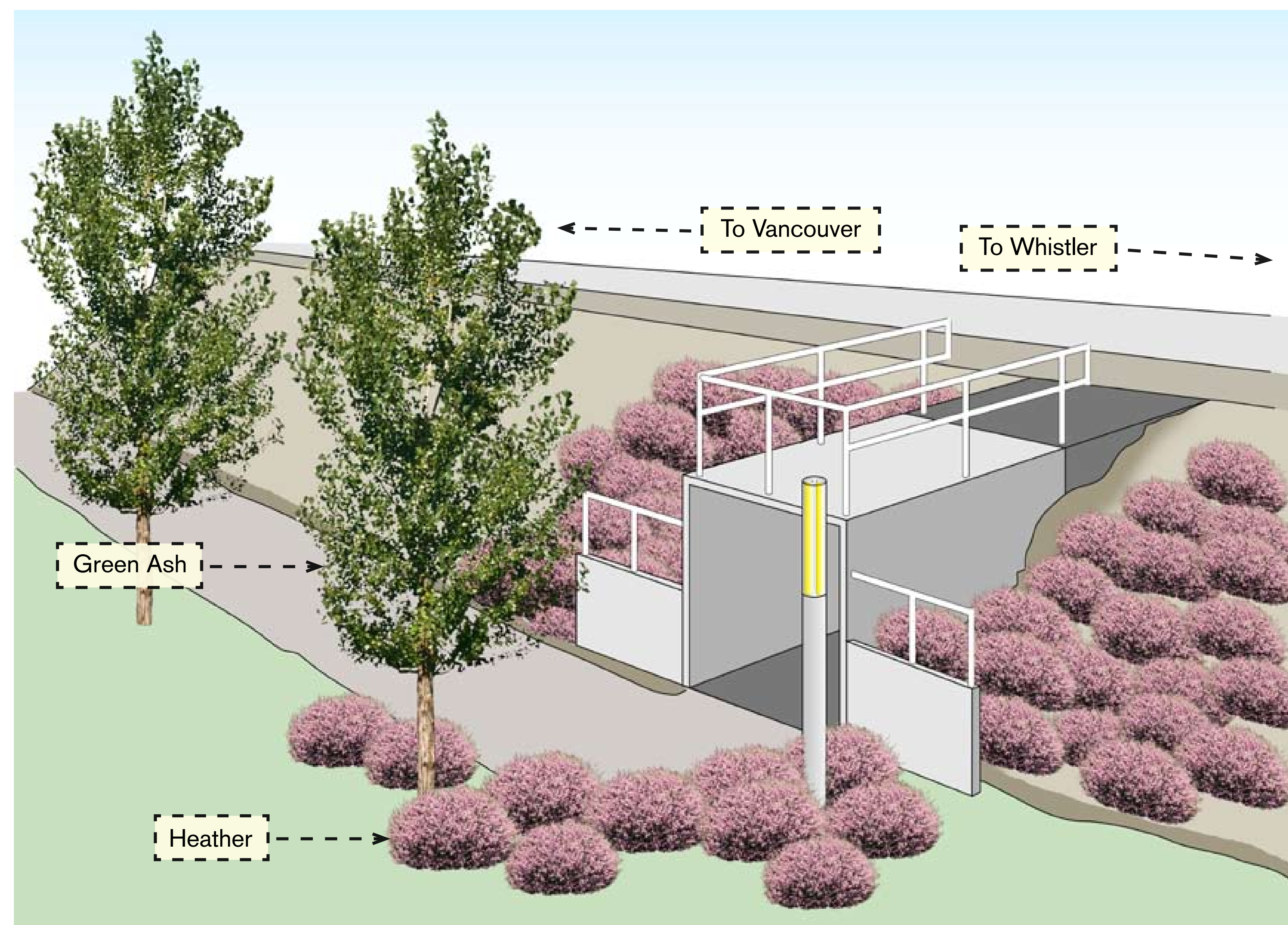
Options for Proposed Light Standards

Two style options for the proposed lamp standards are presented for review and input from the community. One style of lamp standard matches the existing lamp standards within Furry Creek. The other style of the proposed lamp standard is unique to the underpass/trail area.
