

# A New 2-Lane Furry Creek Bridge



To accommodate a four-lane highway throughout the Furry Creek community, a new two-lane bridge for northbound traffic is required over Furry Creek.

The new bridge will be higher than the existing highway bridge to comply with high water regulations. The higher bridge means that the northbound and southbound lanes will be grade-separated, with the northbound lanes about 4 metres higher than the southbound lanes, for approximately 800 metres.

The addition of this bridge eliminates the current highway constriction point of the existing crossings, and will improve safety by eliminating the need for merging the southbound traffic to one lane. In addition, the free flow of traffic in both directions will improve the ease with which residents access the highway.
