

## SEA-TO-SKY HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT COMMUNITY CONSULTATION – SQUAMISH

The Ministry of Transportation would like to invite Squamish residents and corridor park users to provide input and feedback on draft design options for improvements to the Sea-to-Sky Highway in the Squamish area and near Murrin Park, Shannon Falls and the Stawamus Chief.

The Ministry of Transportation is undertaking improvements to the highway between Horseshoe Bay and Whistler to improve the highway's safety and reliability. Highway improvements will make travel along the corridor safer for residents, commuters and tourists. Improvements will include highway widening and straightening, improved sightlines, passing lanes and other design innovations and measures to reduce hazards, shorten travel times and increase capacity of the Sea-to-Sky Highway.

Improvement options address project goals and community concerns. Draft design options will be visually presented to the community and stakeholders with summary information about key characteristics such as access, costs, benefits and how each option addresses project goals and community concerns.
