Community Rings Option

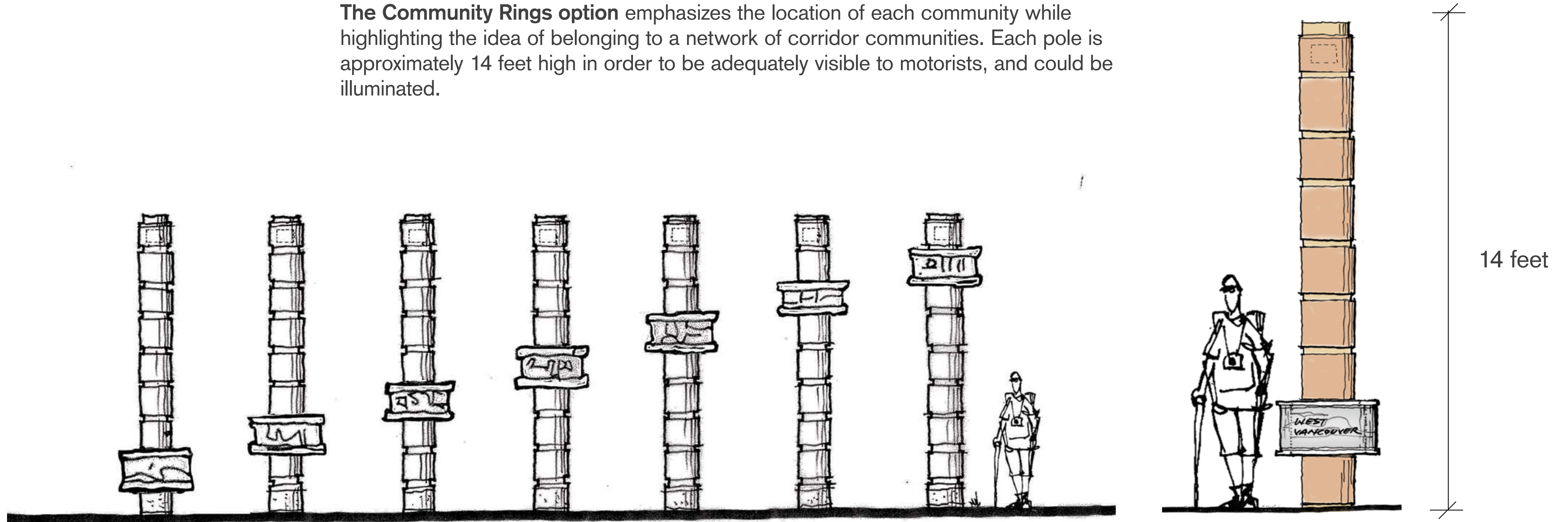
Elements of Continuity

- vertical pole (wood or metal)

Elements of Distinction

- unique glass-like, metal or wooden coloured band featuring the name of community
- emphasizes name of community being entered
- considers input from the community

The **Community Rings option** emphasizes the location of each community while highlighting the idea of belonging to a network of corridor communities. Each pole is approximately 14 feet high in order to be adequately visible to motorists, and could be illuminated.



Community Blades Option

Elements of Continuity

- base fabricated from solid wood beam

Elements of Distinction

- metal or wooden blade that fits into wood base
- considers input from the community

The **Community Blade option** integrates with the surrounding environment and history of the area. This option features a simple, contemporary geometric form and is adaptable to other signage uses of different scales. The feature would be approximately 14 feet high in order to be adequately visible to motorists, and could be illuminated.
