## **West Vancouver Open Houses**

The Ministry of Transportation invites West Vancouver residents to provide feedback on draft design options for improvements to the Sea-to-Sky Highway in the West Vancouver area.

The Ministry of Transportation is undertaking improvements to the highway between Horseshoe Bay and Whistler to improve its safety and reliability. By 2009, extensive highway improvements will make travel along the corridor safer for residents, commuters and tourists. Improvements will include highway widening and straightening, improved sightlines, additional passing lanes and other design innovations and measures to reduce hazards, shorten travel times and increase capacity of the Sea-to-Sky Highway.

Improvement options address project goals and community concerns to varying degrees. Each option will be visually presented to the community and stakeholders with summary information about key characteristics such as access, costs, benefits and how each option addresses project goals and community concerns.
