The Sea-to-Sky Highway Improvement Project invites local residents and stakeholders to provide feedback on preliminary design options for improvements to the Brandywine to Function Junction section of the Sea-to-Sky Highway.

Improvements are being undertaken to the highway between Horseshoe Bay and Whistler to improve safety, reliability and capacity. By 2009, extensive highway improvements will make travel along the highway safer and more reliable for residents, commuters and tourists.

The consultation with the community of Whistler includes gathering community feedback and input regarding refinements to gateways, landscaping, a northbound viewpoint and additional chain-up area.
